General Rules and Regulation for students and staff.

ITPL is committed to promoting values like integrity, excellence, responsibility, diversity, and inclusivity. To ensure a safe and respectful environment for everyone, the following rules apply:

- 1. Complete all registration and pay your tuition and other fees by the given deadlines.
- 2. Attend classes regularly. Excessive absences may lead to penalties. Actively participate in class discussions and group activities.
- 3. Submit original work. Plagiarism, cheating, or any form of dishonesty is not allowed.
- 4. Treat everyone with respect, including staff, service workers, and fellow students. Avoid any form of discrimination, harassment, or behaviour that harms others' emotional wellbeing or reputation.
- 5. Always carry your ITPL ID card and present it when requested. Physical assault or any behavior that endangers others is strictly prohibited.
- 6. Visitors are not allowed on campus unless accompanied by a student/staff. Students/staff are responsible for their guests' behaviour.
- Use ITPL facilities (libraries, labs, study areas) responsibly and leave them in good condition. Respect ITPL property and the property of others. Keep shared spaces clean and avoid littering.
- 8. Behave in a way that protects your own health and safety, as well as that of others. Gambling, drugs, and alcohol are not allowed on campus.
- 9. Dress appropriately on campus. Wear national dress during class hours (Bhutanese students).
- 10. Use personal devices (phones, laptops, etc.) responsibly. Do not use them during lectures unless permitted by the instructor.
- 11. Report any violations of the rules to faculty or administration without fear of retaliation.
- 12. Breaking the rules can lead to disciplinary actions, including warnings, probation, or expulsion. Students have the right to appeal decisions.
- 13. Students are responsible for their actions and decisions, both academically and socially, within the ITPL community.
